

UC Berkeley Law School (Boalt Hall) professor John Yoo, while working as deputy assistant attorney general for the Bush administration's Office of Legal Counsel, wrote the legal justification for torture, allowing cruel and inhuman interrogation methods, and providing immunity for the torturers.

Real people are suffering excruciating torments without any legal process as a result of the legal opinions and arguments of Yoo and his allies.

"John Yoo's complicity in establishing the policy that led to the torture of prisoners constitutes a war crime under the US War Crimes Act," according to testimony in Congress on May 6 by National Lawyers Guild President Marjorie Cohn.
